Peggy and Mark have a blended family of six out-of-the-nest children and one granddaughter. Mark is a musician and song-writer, hiker, amateur naturalist and lover of dead languages.



Rev. Dr. Hardel has served the Church for 40 years as an ordained Lutheran clergyperson as pastor, assistant to the bishop, executive director of The Youth & Family Institute, speaker,
