HB391: Require Local User Fees on Exempt Property

Montana Legislature HB391 would require local user fees on certain exempt property. The bill is similar to repeated past attempts by the Montana Legislature to levy fees or taxes on nonprofits. In this case both cities and counties would be **mandated** to assess user fees on certain tax-exempt organizations, including churches, museums, and affordable housing. Read the bill text to learn more, including if you are on the list of nonprofit types that would be assessed.

This is an example of how church and state intersect and why a conversation among us as members of the body of Christ matters in the real world. So please take part in the <u>Study for the Church</u>, <u>State and Civic Engagement Social Statement</u> to explore how the religious and government spheres may intersect.

As you begin a new year with your council, you may find this digital class helpful. It was taught by our MT Synod Treasurer, Dave Scholten this past January, 2023.




