Words from the Synod: NRIT Serving the Montana Synod for 45 Years

In the mid 1970s a number of education centers were created for ALC Lutheran clergy. Some were placed in colleges or other institutions and others, like the Northern Rockies Institute of Theology, were free standing.

Marc Kolden became the first director of NRIT in 1978 and he was also the teacher,

giving instruction in systematic theology and ethics among other areas. By 1980, Marc had recruited Peter Sethre, Jim Aageson and Tom Lee, all pastors in Montana, to help in providing courses for pastors.

When Kolden returned to Luther Seminary, Eldon Olson was hired, again as director/instructor. Olson also recruited area pastors to teach, along with some college and seminary professors.

When the ELCA was formed, Tom Lee became interim director during the time of transition. He kept NRIT going as the newly formed Montana Synod determined how to



offer continuing education. Ultimately, the Montana Synod decided to continue NRIT, acknowledging the ministry as important to the work of pastors and churches.

Jessica Crist was hired as part-time director and served for twice as long as any of her predecessors. She served as director of NRIT until she was elected as bishop in 2007. Crist guided NRIT into a new model in which both area teachers, as well as faculty from around the country, came to provide education on a diversity of topics. The ministry flourished under her leadership.

When Jessica Crist was elected as bishop, Laurie Jungling served as interim director from 2007-2008. Jungling was hired as faculty at Augustana College after that year and Jenny Kunka became NRIT Director. She still serves in that position.

Throughout NRIT's 45 years, the ministry has continually adapted as it responds to a changing church and to new challenges and joys of doing ministry in the world.

NRIT offerings now include laity, LPAs and rostered leaders. The ministry also welcomes students to learn via digital classes, Zoom offerings, in-person one-day courses and retreats.
