News from Aaron Decker, **ELCA** Missionary in Bolivia

What is the Church?

When Raymundo cut his finger off at work and ended up in the hospital, it was just icing on the cake. The whole holiday season had been a disaster. They lost several farm animals to disease, crops were failing without rain, and now he couldn't go to his second job, in construction, for months while he healed. He lay in bed in one of the two rooms of his mud-brick home, wondering why God was so cruel.

God, of course, is not. We all tend to blame God when things go wrong, but God promises instead to walk with us. We will have to face

So one Sunday late in January, Ark of God Lutheran worshiped not at their building, but in Raymundo's front yard. Plastic chairs and table were enough as the they came together to support their friends **in** Christ.

The congregation had called the central church offices, asking for someone to join them. Three of us came. A national church council member drove. I gave my first Spanish sermon without a manuscript. The Church's Secretary of Mission blessed the family and with water and prayer. What a gift to be the sign of *your* presence for them that day.

What is the church? Among other things, we are the presence of Christ in the world. We show people that they are not alone; God, and God's people, is here on the journey with them. With all of us.

It is because of you that I am not alone in my ministry. Thank you!
