
ELCA World Hunger's Daily Bread Matching Grants support congregations and their partners as they work

toward a just world where all are fed. Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) congregations with feeding ministries are eligible to participate. In this round, approximately 50 grants are available to eligible ministries.

If your congregation sponsors a feeding ministry, please reach out to Pastor Peggy Paugh Leuzinger, Director for Evangelical Mission for the Montana Synod for assistance to apply for the Daily Bread Matching Grant.

The Grant process opens on April 26^{th} , and is only open until May 7^{th} , so timing is important. If your application is approved, you will be able to invite your congregation, networks and friends to donate to kickstart your campaign, and the funds you raise will be matched by ELCA World Hunger with a grant of \$500.
