10 Day Footsteps of Luther Tour

Day 1: Leave from Billings for Frankfurt am Main

Day 2: Arrive in Frankfurt am Main, coach transfer to Mainz. Visit Gutenberg Museum, St. Martin's Cathedral. Free time in Mainz central square area to shop and acclimate. Check into hotel.

Day 3: Coach to Worms. "Here I stand marker", Holy Sands Cemetery, the Imperial Cathedral, Altportal, free time to explore scenic Heidelberg. Return to Mainz.

Day 4: Coach to Wurzburg for free time and lunch then on to Eisenach where Luther attended school and to see the famed Wartburg Castle, where Luther translated the Bible into German. Overnight in Eisenach.

Day 5: Eisenach-Visit Luther House, St. George's Church. Coach to Erfurt. Augustinian Monastery. St. Mary's Cathedral. Overnight in Eisleben.

Day 6: Eisleben – St. Peter/Paul Church, St. Andrew's, St. Anne's church, Steinbilder-Bible. Overnight in Eisleben

Day 7: Buchenwald/Leipzig – Buchenwald Concentration Camp. Leipzig–, Goethe Memorial, St. Nicholas Church, Free time in Leipzig city center.

Day 8: Leipzig/Torgau - Hartenfels Castle and the Palace Chapel, Katharina Luther Parlor.

Day 9: Wittenberg - St. Mary's Church, Luther Hall, All Saints Church where Luther nailed the 95 Theses to the Door

Day 10: Return to Leipzig for return home
