# Growing the ELCA

- ✓ 82 new starts total begun during pandemic so far.
- ✓ 528 new ministries have been organized as congregations since the birth of the ELCA in 1988.
- ✓ 380 new starts are active now.
- ✓ 1500+ leaders register and participate in **Congregational Development Trainings online each** year.
- ✓ The ELCA has committed to providing a Director for Evangelical Mission in each synod for the purpose of helping congregations reach new, young, diverse people.



# LUTHERAN DISASTER RESPONSE

#### Buttalo, NY

Working with a long-time partner on addressing peace, reconciliation, and trauma counseling in Buffalo. They will work closely with a new-start mission called "Community of Good Neighbor."

### Uvalde, TX

Working with ecumenical partner to provide a pastoral presence Support for chaplain services

Offer financial support for funeral services to families in need

### **COVID-19 Response Fund**

Since the COVID-19 Response Fund was established last year, the organization has raised more than \$2.1 million in funding from generous ELCA members. Donations are still being accepted and are now being distributed through such churchwide ministries as ELCA World Hunger and Lutheran Disaster Response

### Humanitarian Response in Eastern Europe

Lutheran Disaster Response has so far contributed over \$8.9 million to Lutheran World Federation, the ACT Alliance / Hungarian Interchurch Aid, Evangelical Lutheran Church in Hungary (ELCH) and RGDTS-Phiren Amenca to provide immediate and long-term relief assistance to Ukrainian refugees arriving in Poland, Slovakia, Hungary and Romania. Implementing partners provide food, temporary shelter, cash assistance, hygiene kits, medical care and psychosocial / pastoral counseling to those that recently arrived, some of whom are African Nationals and people of Roma-descent.

# Hunger and Big Dream Grants

286 ELCA World Hunger grants were provided internationally to support the work of companion churches, organizations, and ecumenical partners in 66 countries with a total international expenditure of over \$14.5 million.

167 ELCA Domestic Hunger Grants, 4 Big Dream Grants, and 36 Daily Bread Matching Grants were awarded across 63 synods, with a total award amount of over \$1.25 million.




