Wrestling with Colonization and the Processes of Colonialism to Strengthen Ministry

Online Class: Part one of a two-part course presented by the Montana Synod Racial Justice Task Force

Wednesday mornings on Zoom 9:00 – 10:15 am

September 6 - October 4

Cost: \$125 for this course. Part two will have a separate registration.

What is involved in becoming allies to Indigenous people and communities? It takes time and patience to build trusting, respectful relationships beginning with hearing about Indigenous life conditions, wants, desires, and needs.

This course will lay a foundation for this work.

Topics include: identities—settler and Indigenous, a brief review of history, settler goals, rationalization and tools, and Indigenous traumas, resistance and resilience. Participants will be asked to read or watch videos in preparation for each Zoom session. Class sessions will include speakers, small group discussion and q & a.
