# Words from the Bishop: Rocky Boy Parsonage Fund



Today I come to you on behalf of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church at Rocky Boy. As some of you may know, the people of Our Saviour's Lutheran and the Rocky Boy community have been without a Lutheran pastor for over a year and a half. I, working with Vance Blackfox at the ELCA Churchwide Office and the Montana Synod Council, continue to search for a dedicated and capable pastor to serve alongside the Chippewa and Cree people in their context.

However, we have discovered that the parsonage at Our Saviour's is unlivable. Even as we search for and encourage a new pastor to consider this exciting call, we need to replace the parsonage.

#### And so we are asking for your support!



This past summer, Our Saviour's, Rocky Boy received a gift of \$34,000+ from Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Cheney, WA as part of that congregation's holy closure legacy. After a conversation with the leaders of Our Saviour's, it was decided that the Montana/Northern Wyoming Synod would use this generous gift as seed money towards replacing the parsonage.

But we need this gift to grow into at least \$250,000, the anticipated cost of a modular home.

#### To accomplish this goal, we are **challenging the congregations, ministries, and individuals of the Montana/Northern Wyoming Synod and many other supporters across the country to match the original gift of \$34,000, not once or twice but 7 times**.

And we'd like to do this by Easter 2024 so that we can get the parsonage placed before potential pastoral candidates become available (weather cooperating).

Why are we doing this? There is great opportunity for new and exciting ministry with, by and for the people of Our Saviour's and the Chippewa and Cree tribes at Rocky Boy. And it is vitally important that whoever serves as the pastoral leader of the congregation actually live on site. For it is only in living with the people that holy relationships of accompaniment can truly grow.

You may give to this special restricted fund that has been established for this campaign in three ways at this time. All monies given to this fund will go toward the new parsonage.

1. Send a check to the Montana Synod office made out to the "Montana Synod ELCA" with "Parsonage for Rocky Boy" in the memo line. (1221 24<sup>th</sup> St S., Great Falls, MT, 59405)

2. Click the "Give" button on the <u>Montana Synod website</u>. In the dropdown box select "Parsonage for Rocky Boy" to give to this special fund. (link to website)

# 3. Congregations: give using your normal monthly or quarterly giving to the Montana Synod by designating an amount for "Parsonage for Rocky Boy" on your remittance form.

Thank you for your generous support of one of the oldest ministries in the synod. There may also come a time next spring when volunteer support from individuals and congregations will be needed so please keep that in mind. And of course your prayers are always welcome.
